Web Usability Report - New "Imu.de" Website

(Per-group homework, 2 weeks)

For the prototype of the forthcoming new LMU website, use appropriate methods to evaluate the web usability. The prototype website is not complete, you will need to imagine what the missing parts and features will look like. The prototype's URL is confidential, it will be given in the lecture and exercises sessions.

Create a **detailed** usability report (two examples are given below) for the new LMU website. As with the previous homework, use the checklist to inspect the website, find issues that are potential problems and rate the severity. Additionally, suggest possible improvements based on the previous homework (in particular with regard to particular user groups).

Your work can influence the design of the relaunched lmu.de website! The best usability reports will be made available to members of the LMU "Internet-Referat", who will also be present at the exercises sessions.
