3. Purposes and legal bases of the processing

I consent to the collection and anonymous recording of data about me in the course of the study.

The following data will be processed:

- Demographic information (age in years, gender, education level).
- Questionnaire responses about the working situation, current amount, frequency and satisfaction of social interactions, self-reflection, self-consciousness, and personality
- Follow-up survey on app usage, as well as user input, usability of the app, social interactions, general self-reflection and self-consciousness, self-reflection through the app, and feedback on the app concept

For study purposes the “Social Journal” app

- requires access to the time and duration of outgoing and incoming phone calls
- will send push-notifications
- will collect all entered data together with the exact time the data was entered
- will record the screen time on the different screens while using the app

As part of the study, I will receive a participation code. The code will be used to manage the data of the study. My name will not be associated with the data collected or the study code.

3.a. Purposes of processing:

I agree that my data may be collected by LMU Munich for the following purposes of collection, processing, use and storage:

- The results and collected data of this study will be published as a scientific publication by LMU Munich. This will be done in a completely anonymized form, i.e. without the data being can be assigned to the respective participants of the study.
- The anonymized data will be stored for an indefinite period of time.

3.b. Legal basis of processing

Your data are processed on the basis of Act 6 para. 1 a, Act 7, Act 9 para. 2 a, Act 89, Act 156 and Act 159 GDPR and Act 25 BayDSG.

4. Recipients or categories of recipients of personal data

I have been informed that the personal data collected within the scope of the aforementioned purposes personal data of my person will be processed in compliance with the Data Protection Act (DSGVO and BayDSG) will be processed.

5. Duration of storage of personal data

The deletion of your contact data (email address) is carried out in accordance with the Principles of Research on Humans of the German Research Foundation (DFG). These personal data will be deleted as soon as they are no longer needed to recruit the subjects or for inquiries.

The remaining data collected will be anonymized after completion of the scientific project (December 2023). The raw data will be deleted at this time. The anonymized data *will not be deleted*.

6. Rights of persons affected

According to the General Data Protection Regulation, you have the following rights:

If your personal data are processed, you have the right to obtain information on the data stored about you (Act 15 GDPR).

If incorrect personal data are processed, you are entitled to a correction (Act 16 GDPR).

If the legal prerequisites exist, you can request the deletion or limitation of the processing and appeal against the processing (Acts 17, 18 and 21 GDPR).

If you have consented to the data processing or to a data-processing contract and the data processing is carried automatically, you may be entitled to data transferability (Act 20 GDPR).

If you make use of your rights mentioned above, the public office checks whether the legal requirements for these are met.

Furthermore, there is a right of appeal to the Bavarian State Commissioner for Data Protection.
